STCW + DSD

STCW stands for the Standards of Training, Certification, and Watchkeeping for Seafarers.

It is an international convention established by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) to ensure that seafarers are adequately trained, qualified, and certified to perform their duties on ships.



WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?



All Seafarers must obtain STCW certificates, which verify their qualifications and competency to work in specific roles onboard ships.

STCW plays a crucial role in standardizing maritime training and safety, ensuring that seafarers are equipped to handle their responsibilities effectively.

Acquiring an STCW is the first step, basic entry qualification, for someone looking to work in the industry and is valid for 5 years, after every 5 years regardless of experience Seafarers are required to complete the courses again.

STCW aims to promote safety at sea, protect the marine environment, and ensure the welfare of seafarers by setting minimum training standards.

STCW specifies the competencies required for different positions. This includes practical skills, theoretical knowledge, and safety awareness.

It establishes guidelines for watchkeeping duties to ensure safe and effective operation of ships at sea, including navigational watch and engine room watch.

WHAT STCW COURSE COVERS

The STCW covers a wide range of competencies, including safety training, medical care, fire-fighting, and survival at sea, as well as specialized training for different types of vessels and roles. The standards are regularly updated to reflect changes in technology, safety practices, and operational procedures.

The convention outlines specific training requirements for various roles in the maritime industry, including Deck / Engine officers; Ratings (crew members) i.e. Stews and Deckhands.

WHAT DSD COURSE COVERS

The Designated Security Duties module is designed for all crew members to be able to understand and perform all necessary security duties assigned to them.

After completion of this course crew members will be able to perform assigned safety procedures.

This course is a requirement for all crew members and forms part of the STCW Certification.

The Designated Security Duties pertain to only one of the STCW required certificates.

COURSE CONTENT

- Understand the importance of safety onboard.
- Be able to perform allocated security duties.
- Be able to understand security plans and what you are responsible for.
- Understand different security levels and what that means for the safety of the vessel and crew.
- Learn about different security services including piracy and robbery.
- Inspection of security equipment.

DURATION:

- Basic Fire Fighting and Fire Prevention (MFF or FPF) - 3 Days
- Elementary First Aid (EFA) - 2 Days
- Personal Survival Techniques (PST) - 2 Days
- Personal Safety & Social Responsibility (PSSR) - 2 Days
- Designated Security Duties (PDSD) - 2 Days
