TENDER OPERATOR

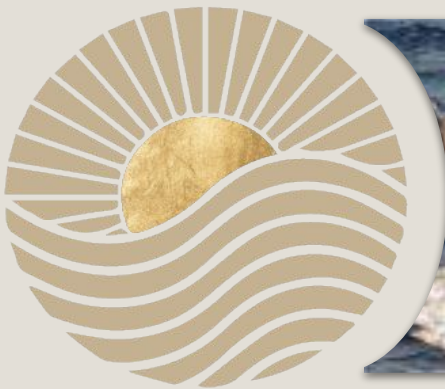
A tender on a superyacht is a small boat or dinghy used to transport guests and crew from the yacht to shore or between different yachts, as well as for water activities like snorkeling, diving, or fishing.

Not to be confused with the RYA Powerboat Level 2.

Tenders are often powered by an outboard engine and can vary in size, from small inflatables to larger, more luxurious vessels.

This course is designed to build on your basic power boating skills, helping you gain confidence in your abilities.

You will have ample opportunity to practice various techniques, both with a crew member and while working alone. The main focus of the course is on ship-to-shore transfers and the essential skills related to this, rather than coastal cruising.



WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?



With this licence, you'll have the necessary knowledge to communicate effectively and comply with maritime regulations, ensuring both your safety and the safety of others on the water.

This is invaluable to Skippers, crew members (Deckhands and Stews), private boat owners, and maritime professionals.

For those working on superyachts, while it may not be strictly required for all crew members, having a basic understanding of VHF radio operation is highly beneficial, especially in emergency situations.

REQUIREMENTS

- You must hold the RYA Powerboat Level 2 with coastal endorsement to continue with this.
- It is recommended that candidates hold a valid STCW Elementary First Aid Certificate and the RYA VHF SRC certificate.



WHAT THIS COURSE COVERS

Throughout the course, you will develop a clear understanding of your role and responsibilities as a tender skipper, learning to helm with precision and safety.

- Launching and recovering using yacht davits
- Maneuvering in confined spaces
- Mooring techniques and beach landings
- Responsibilities of the skipper
- Managing guests and crew
- Ensuring guest safety and care
- Man-overboard drills (both day and night)
- Anchoring techniques
- Performing engine checks
- High-speed handling
- Collision regulations
- Buoyage systems
- Using GPS plotters and depth equipment
- Effective communication while afloat
- Understanding local rules and regulations
